



the idea

to marry the powerful and warm structure of Fiano with the fresh and aromatic texture of Incrocio Manzoni grapes

the vines varieties

85% Fiano

15% Incrocio Manzoni

the vineyard

surface: 1,20 Ha

plantation spacing: 2,50x0,80

density: 5.000 stocks/Ha

altitude: 180 m o.s.l.

direction of slope: south, south-east

pruning system: Fiano: Guyot; Incr. Manzoni: runner Cordon

year of plantation: 2003

soil: loamy, calcareous, with soil skeleton

yield: grapes: 7t/Ha; must: 35 hl/Ha

in the Vineyard

winter pruning, vine shoot's selection, leaf stripping, green pruning, grape's thinning, harvest by hand: **Incrocio Manzoni:** 3rd week of August; **Fiano:** I. week of September

in the cellar

destalking of grapes; soft pressing (0,4 bar); cold must clearing; alcoholic fermentation under temperature control; refining in stanley steel casks on the yeasts for about 4 months; filtering (0,4 μ); bottling.
